The new board is off to a **ROARING** start and have already planned **B-I-N-G-O** evenings for us each month this summer.

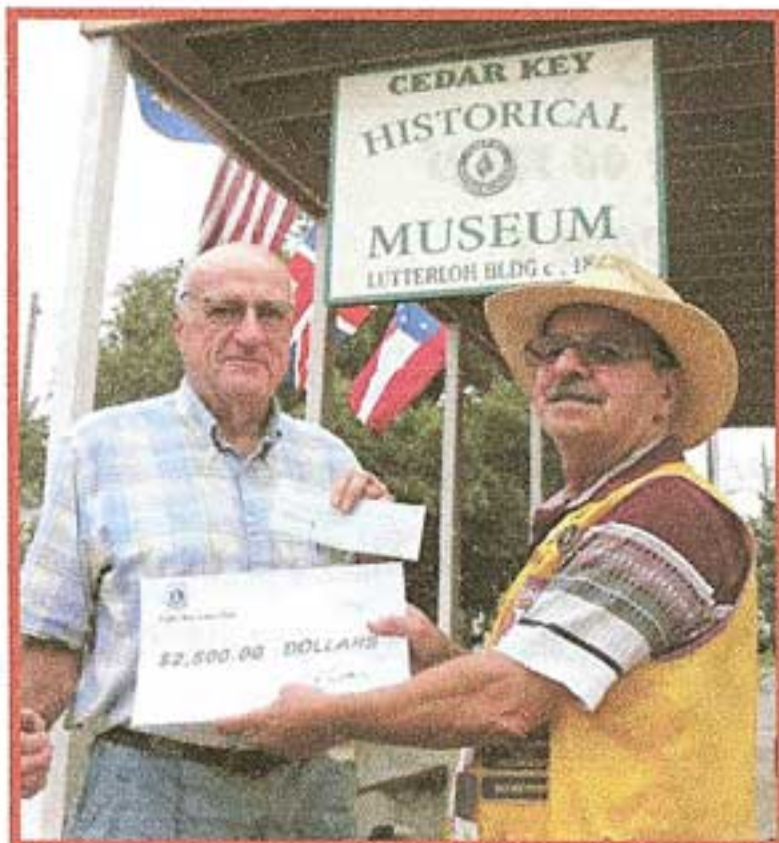
Board and Member meetings in review
