Discussion of the music in the park at the upcoming Seafood festival led to approval of Anna White's suggestion to accept the assistance of Butch Wise in organizing the groups to participate. 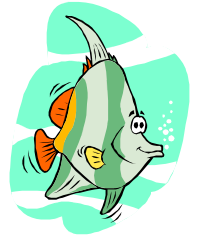
